## General Installation Instructions

Applying your new decal is a very simple process but make sure to take your time. Below are some tips to help make the installation process go a little smoother. Please read them completely before you start.

## Tools needed:

Rubbing alcohol
Squeegee with felt edge or a credit card wrapped in a towel or microfiber cloth (wrapped to prevent scratches)
Spray bottle with soapy water (a drop or two of liquid dish soap in a $160 z$ spray bottle)
Microfiber cloth
Razor blade (only needed if mounting holes are present)
Hair Dryer/Heat Gun (optional)

## Installation Steps:

Step 1: Thoroughly clean area of all debris using rubbing alcohol and/or soap and water.

Step 2: Using the soapy water, spray the area where the decal will be installed. (More is better!)

Step 3: Spray the back of the decal. Pro tip - Spray your fingertips too so the decal doesn't stick to your hands. This makes is easier to apply.

Step 4: Apply decal.
Step 5: Once the decal is centered, use the squeegee to flatten the decal and remove all bubbles and liquids from underneath.
(if there is no room for a tool use your finger to contour the decal into place)
(if the decal isn't sticking allow it to dry a bit, it becomes more tacky as it dries)
(if wrinkles are in the material, apply light heat from a hair dryer/heat gun will relax the vinyl)
(if mounting holes are present cut an ' $X$ ' using a razor and fold the flaps into the hole and affix)
Step 6: Let it sit over night to fully adhere
